The 'Einspanner' (Lone Horse)

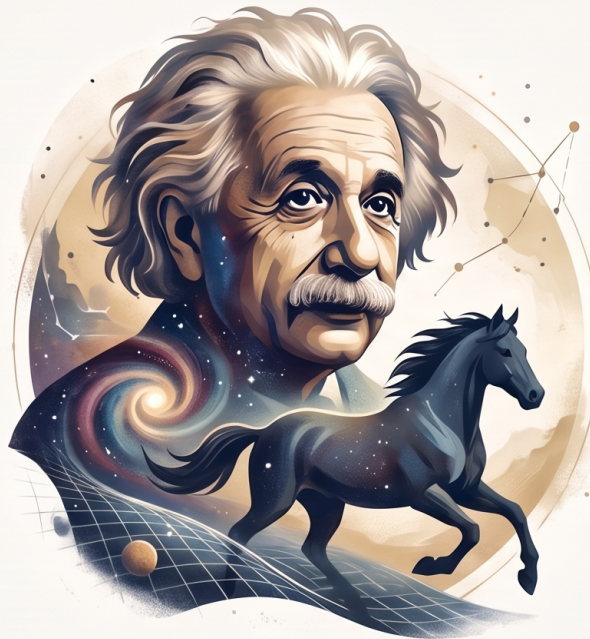
Einstein embraced the role of the independent thinker, questioning absolute time and space.

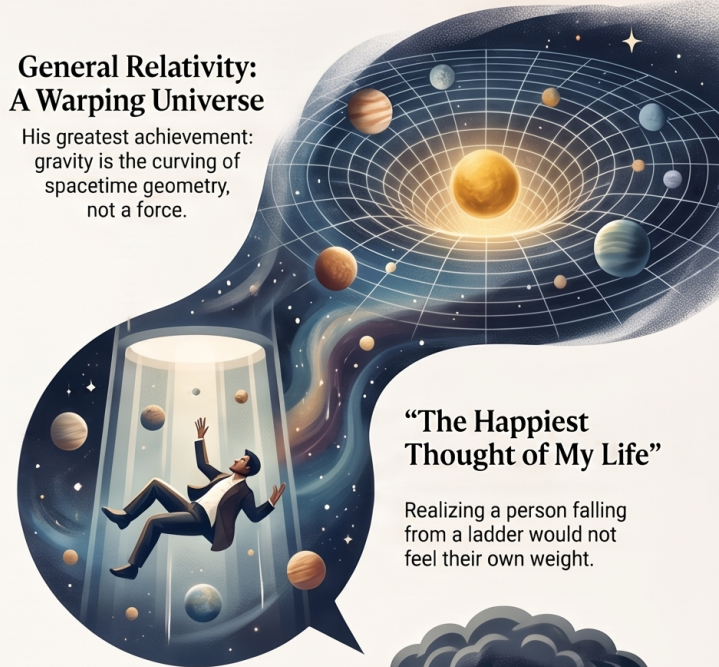


View on Peace
